8.	CANONICITY: Many of the religious systems around us are based on ongoing revelation. What are some of the benefits to you of a closed canon, especially as it relates to your salvation? What implication would an open canon have on the sufficiency of Christ's work on the cross?
9.	SUFFICIENCY: How does Scripture's sufficiency encourage you when you find yourself in a trial? What principles do you keep in view when you consider the availability of excellent extra-biblical material?
