Application

- Worship Yahweh
 - o He is sovereign
 - o He is faithful
 - o He is compassionate
 - o He is good (Romans 8:28).
 - o He is holy (Ex. 15:11).
- Pray:
 - o God accomplishes his purposes *through* His people's prayer.
 - o Pray for strength (1 John 4:4; Phil. 4:10-13; 1 Cor. 10:13).
- Remember God's name.
- Take comfort in God's presence
- Trust God's purposes in your proclamation
- Rejoice in the Work of Christ:
 - o Christ, the Passover Lamb (1 Cor 5:7).
 - o The torn veil and access to God (Mt. 27:51; Mk. 15:38; Hb. 9:3; Hb. 10:20).
- Be watchful:
 - o Sin is deceitful and hardness of heart is real (Heb. 3:12-19).
 - o You must know Yahweh.
 - o Your children must know Yahweh (Ex. 10:1-2).
 - o Put off grumbling and cultivate gratitude (1 Cor. 10:11; 1 Thess. 5:18; Phil. 2:14).
